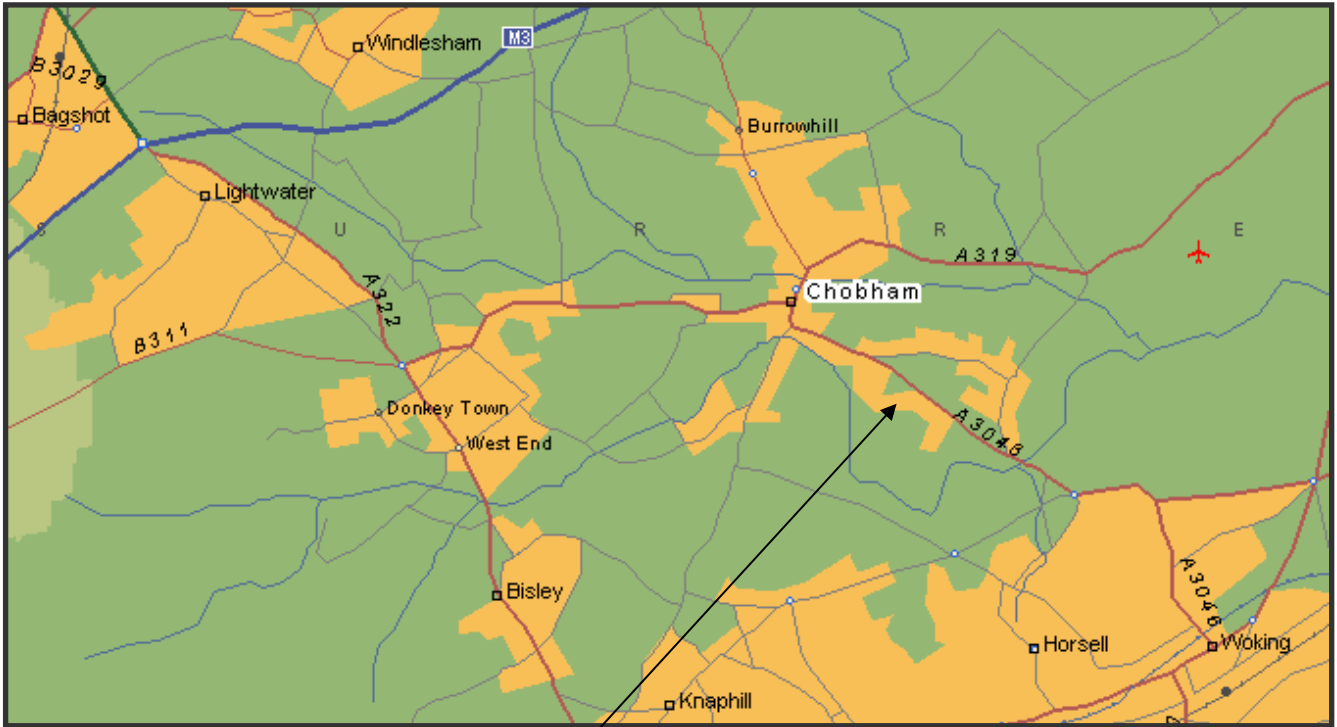

Terms and Conditions Of Sale.

1. All items are offered subject to being unsold on receipt of order.
2. Advance orders are taken subject to crop reaching specifications by the time the plants are required.
3. Customers are requested to telephone before calling to collect an order. For large orders, please give as much notice as possible.
4. Delivery by arrangement at cost.
5. Payment terms are 'nett monthly' (i.e. payment not later than end of month following date of invoice).
6. We reserve the right to charge interest at 5% per month on overdue accounts.
7. New customers are requested to give two trade references at the time of placing an order.
8. This catalogue cancels all previous catalogues.
9. For customers who usually have less than 5 plants of a variety, a 10% surcharge will be levied to cover the additional administrative costs.
10. All prices are nett of V.A.T.
11. Risk of any orders dispatched by *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* will pass to the customer on receipt of goods. Therefore complaints must be registered in writing within seven days of this date.
12. Notwithstanding delivery and the passing of risk in the goods, or any other provision of these conditions, the property in the goods shall not pass to the buyer until *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* have received in cash or cleared funds payment in full of the price of the goods and all other goods agreed to be sold by *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* to the buyer for which payment is then due.
13. Until such time as the property in the goods passes to the buyer, the buyer shall hold the goods as *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* fiduciary agent and bailee and shall keep the goods separate from those of the buyer, and the third parties and properly stored, protected and insured and identified as *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* property. Until that time, the buyer shall be entitled to resell or use the goods in the ordinary course of its business, but shall account to *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* for the proceeds or otherwise of the goods, whether intangible or tangible, including insurance proceeds and shall keep all such proceeds separate from any monies or property of the buyer and third parties and, in the case of tangible proceeds, properly stored protected and insured.
14. Until such time as the property in the goods passes to the buyer (and provided the goods are still in existence and have not been resold) *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* shall be entitled at any time to require the buyer to deliver up the goods to *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* and, if the buyer fails to do so forthwith, to enter upon the premises of the buyer or any third party where the goods are stored and repossess the goods.
15. The buyer shall not be entitled to pledge or in any way charge by way of security for any indebtedness any of the goods which remain the property of *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* but if the buyer does so all monies owed by the buyer to *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* shall (without prejudice to any other right or remedy of *Creative Plant Supplies Limited*) forthwith become due and payable.
16. *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* reserves the right to withhold deliveries to any customer who has failed to settle any outstanding sum on their account.
17. *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* shall not be liable for damage or loss caused as a result of any occurrence beyond the company's control.
18. Whilst every effort is made to ensure that plants dispatched are of first grade quality and true to name, should a claim result *Creative Plant Supplies Limited* liability shall not exceed the invoice price of the goods in question.
